
Incontinence protection pads designed to provide air permeability and absorbancy which may contribute to microclimate management. Tri-dimensional matting creates air-permeable durability.




## **Key features**

Soft, permeable top layer	Allows fluid to pass to the core of the underpad. Keeps moisture away from the patient's skin.
Tri-dimensional matting	Provides tensile strength and durability.
Super absorbent polymers	Draws fluid away from patient's skin and encapsulates it within the core. Absorbs secondary voids reducing associated odors.
Breathable back sheet	Allows underlying microclimate therapies to function properly. <sup>1</sup>

- Provide air permeability which may aid in keeping the patient's skin dry and comfortable.
- Maintain structural integrity due to their tensile strength.
  This may decrease the number of underpad changes required.
