Pre-set rocking programmes combine smooth, quiet motion and soothing music with tactile stimulation to promote physical and mental relaxation, or a refreshing and stimulating experience, depending on the needs of the resident. Each setting is also easily customisable with just the touch of a button.

A choice of optional accessories could add to the user experience. Residents may find that the overall pressure from the weighted blanket combined with the support of the U-shaped cushion and additional positioning accessories provide a sense of security and "cocooning" effect.
